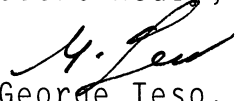

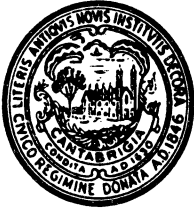
Subject City Council Order #1 of 5/22/89 "Parking on Sidewalk On Linnaean St.
at Massachusetts Avenue"

The Traffic Department has contacted the architect who is working on the building at the corner of Massachusetts Avenue and Linnaean Street and we have decided that the only way we can stop this parking on the sidewalk is to erect a barrier on the property line. It was agreed that a wooden guard rail was the answer.

He will inform the owners of the property that this barrier should be erected. If they take no action on the guard rail we will move the yellow line which is one foot off the property line and vigorously tag the offenders.
