Subject: Letter to the City Council from Robert La Tremouille dated July 6, 1987 re: provisions of the Laverty Petition related to the Residence C-2, C-2B and Business A Zoning Districts.

The Community Development Department has reviewed the comments made in the above referenced letter. When the petition's provisions are reviewed in their entirety, or only those specific provisions cited, it is clear that no modifications to the requirements of the long existing Business A District were intended or were in fact made with the adoption of the Laverty Zoning Petition. The language cited clearly makes a number of provisions applying to the existing Residence C-2 District applicable to the new Residence C-2B District; it does not however alter in any way the relationship of the Residence C-2 District to the Business A District which was not modified by the petition nor ever discussed in any of the many public meetings related to the Petition.
