

CHAPTER 506--1971

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE LAW RELATIVE TO PENSIONS FOR
WIDOWS OF FIRE FIGHTERS KILLED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF DUTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

Section 100 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently amended by Chapter 318 of the acts of 1970, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter or any other law, if a fire fighter while in the performance of his duties and as a result of an accident while responding to or returning from an alarm of fire or any emergency, or while at the scene of a fire or any emergency is killed or sustains injuries which result in his death, or if a police officer while in the performance of his duties and as a result of an assault on his person is killed or sustains injuries which result in his death, there shall be paid to the widow of such fire fighter or such police officer an annual amount of pension which shall be equal to the amount of salary which would have been paid to such fire fighter or such police officer had he continued in service in the position held by him at the time of his death; provided, however, that the amount of pension immediately payable shall be equal to the maximum salary set for the position whether or not such police officer or fire fighter had reached the maximum at the time of his death.

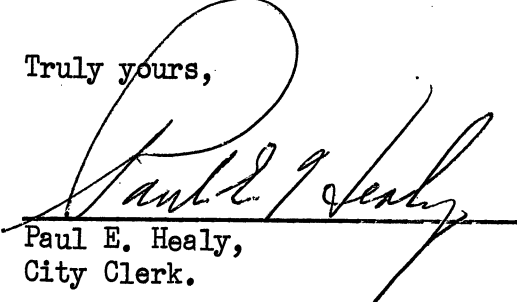
