

Gilbert Boyle, 73, former manager of Herald circulation

Gilbert C. Boyle of Concord, N.H., a former circulation manager for the Boston Herald, died yesterday at Concord Hospital in New Hampshire after a long illness. He was 73.

Born in Canton, he lived in Concord, N.H., for the past 40 years.

Mr. Boyle was a 1935 graduate of Cambridge High and Latin School and a U.S. Army veteran of World War II.

He was employed by the Boston Herald for 35 years and served as circulation manager for Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont.

Mr. Boyle most recently worked as district manager for Cable News Co. Inc. of New York and also as a consultant for Concord Business Magazine.

He was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council 112 in Concord, N.H., and a communicant at St. John the Evangelist Church.

He is survived by his wife, Mary (Keohane); three sons, James of Bow, N.H., Robert of Merrimack, N.H., and Kevin of Concord, N.H.; four daughters, Anne Lafond of Windham, N.H., Elizabeth Monica of Great Falls, Va., Kathleen Kiley of Randolph and Elaine Brodeur of Concord, N.H.; two brothers, John of Woburn and Leo of Cambridge; three sisters, Rita Sullivan and Elizabeth Delaney, both of Cambridge, and Marie Fitzgerald of Rockville, Md.; nine grandchildren; and many nieces, nephews and cousins.

A funeral Mass will be celebrated for Mr. Boyle at 10 a.m. Thursday in St. John the Evangelist Church, 72 South Main St., Concord, N.H.

Burial will be in Blossom Hill Cemetery, Concord, N.H.
