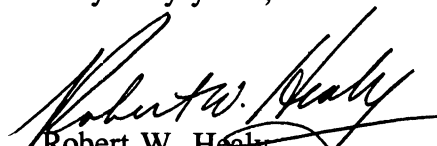

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$24,265.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salaries and Wages Account (\$21,760.00), and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$2,505.00) from the Friends of the Community Learning Center. These funds have been granted to CLC to provide three English as a Second Language classes and to implement a Civic Education Project. Funds will be used to support ESL teacher salaries to run two intermediate ESL classes and one computer class from September 1996 to June 1997. Funds for the Civic Education Project will be used for instruction and to develop curriculum. Non-personnel costs associated with these projects are for educational materials and printing.
