

# City of Cambridge.

In the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty six.

An Ordinance in further addition to an Ordinance "to prevent unlawful and injurious practices in the Streets and other public places in the City."

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows.

Section. 1. No person shall make erect or maintain any gate or door in or upon any street, lane alley or sidewalk in the City, in such manner as when opening the same it shall swing over such street, lane alley or sidewalk.

Section. 2. Any person who shall offend against the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be liable to the forfeitures, and may be prosecuted and tried in the manner prescribed in the Ordinance to which this is in addition.

Section. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on and after the first day of May next.
