IN CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS:

Jeremiah F. Mahoney, a former employee of the Police Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Police Department on June 10, 1919 and was pensioned on June 23, 1952 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 83a, Clause (a), of the General Laws and died on June 23, 1980, having served not less than thirty-three years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Mary M. Mahoney, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Jeremiah F. Mahoney, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Mary M. Mahoney, widow of Jeremiah F. Mahoney, of \$3,000.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.






