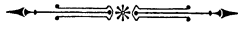

In Board of Aldermen, June 4. 1884

Ordered,

That the Joint Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges be authorized to purchase the open square, situated at the junction of Gore and Bridge streets, said square being private property, and containing about 1300 square feet of land. The entire cost of such purchase not to exceed the sum of \$1300.⁰⁰, the same to be paid in the year 1885, without interest, and the amount thereof to be charged to the proper appropriation of that year.

(June 9, 1884.) Adopted. Sane - second for concurrence.
