WHEREAS:-

It is the policy of the City of Cambridge to encourage registration of all eligible citizens of voting age, and

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Over a thousand people registered to vote in their neighborhoods during the past 2½ weeks of neighborhood registration, now therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to ask the Election Commission to provide further Monday and Thursday registration hours from 6 P.M. to 9 P. M. and Saturday registration hours from 10 A.M. to 2 P. M. at one location in each ward for the period from September 7 to October 7, and be it further

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is also requested to ask the Election Commission to again make available to candidates and community groups 60,000 flyers listing the registration times and locations, the proofs of physical presence and the proofs of residence required by the Election Commission, and bearing the official imprimatur of the Election Commission, and be it further

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is also requested to ask the cooperation of the Library Department in making available the Bookmobile for use as a registration van to be rotated among the various public housing projects in the city during the period from September 7 to October 7 and open for registration from 10 A.M. to 8 P.M. and be it further

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to ask the Election Commission to advertise each week from the week of September 3 to the week of October 1 the registration times and locations on the front page of the Cambridge Chronicle, on the Cambridge page of the Herald Traveler-Record American, and in Boston After Dark, Bay State Banner and the Real Paper, and be it further

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is also requested to make available to the Election Commission funds necessary to cover the costs of the above.
