WHEREAS: Given the growth in the demand for telephone numbers in Eastern Massachusetts, the North American Numbering Plan Administrator projects that there will no longer be sufficient exchange codes within the 617 and 508 area codes by 1998 and 1999, respectively; and

WHEREAS: To determine an appropriate relief plan for addressing the limited number of exchange codes remaining in this area, on May 24, 1996, the Department of Public Utilities opened an investigation and directed that all interested persons file proposals to address the matter; and

WHEREAS: The Department has received two alternative proposals from industry members: the overlay approach and the geographic split; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record as being opposed to any change that will give us more than one area code within the city limits.
