WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of the City Council that His Excellency Kenneth David Kaunda, former president of Zambia, will be a guest of honor at St. Paul AME Church in Cambridge on Sunday June 8, 2003 during Worship Services; and

WHEREAS: Formerly an educator, Dr. Kaunda began his political career as the founder and Secretary of the Lubwa Branch of the African National Congress in 1950. With the development of a new Constitution and the advent of Zambia's first black government in 1962 Dr. Kaunda became Minister of Local Government and Social Welfare and in January 1964, Prime Minister of Northern Rhodesia; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Kaunda was president of Zambia from October, 1964 to 1991; in addition to his work for the people of Zambia, Dr. Kaunda was at the forefront of the efforts to liberate all of Africa during that era; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Kaunda is currently the Balfour African Presidential Scholar at Boston University; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Kaunda is the founder and chairman of the Kenneth Kaunda Children of Africa Foundation, which is mobilizing international support for the youngest victims of the AIDS/HIV pandemic; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Kaunda is the recipient of many honorary degrees and awards for his work in promoting human and civil rights on the African continent; he is also the author of many books and articles grounded in his experiences and his beliefs and practice in the area of liberation, human rights and peace; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record welcoming His Excellency Kenneth David Kaunda, former president of Zambia as he comes to Cambridge on June 8, 2003 as the guest of honor at Worship Services at St. Paul AME Church; and be it further
