WHEREAS: The Citizens of the Republic of Armenia are experiencing extreme hardship in the form of no heat, no electricity, and sometimes no water, as a result of a blockade instituted by Azerbaijan, and de facto blockades perpetrated by Georgia and Turkey; and

WHEREAS: The Citizens of Cambridge, Commonwealth of Massachusetts, are linked in a sister city relationship to Erevan, Armenia, and are concerned about their well-being; now, therefore be it

BE IT RESOLVED: THAT The Cambridge City Council go on record condemning the actions of these countries against Armenia; and urging the United States Government:

- 1) to support the creation of secure unrestricted humanitarian aid corridors through Turkey and
- 2) to encourage Azerbaijan to lift its blockade so that urgently needed fuel, food and medical supplies can be received and another human tragedy may be averted; and be it further
