Meetings.

All regular meetings of the City Council may be held in the City Council Chamber, City Hall, at 7:00 o'clock in the evening of Monday of each week, from the first Monday in January to and including the last Monday in June and from the second Monday in September to and including the last Monday in December, provided, however, that when a meeting day falls on a holiday the succeeding Monday shall be the meeting day, and provided, further, that the City Council may at any meeting, by a majority vote, decide to discontinue any further meetings hereinbefore assigned.

AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an Ordinance entitled: "The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge"

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Chapter 2, entitled "Administration" is hereby amended in Article III, Council, Section 17, Meetings, by striking out said Section 17 and substituting in place thereof a new Section 17, so that said section will read as follows:

Section 17. Meetings.

All regular meetings of the City Council may be held in the City Council Chamber, City Hall, at 7:00 o'clock in the evening of Monday of each week, from the first Monday in January to and including the last Monday in June and from the second Monday in September to and including the last Monday in December, provided, however, that when a meeting day falls on a holiday the succeeding Monday shall be the meeting day, and provided, further, that the City Council may at any meeting, by a majority vote, decide to discontinue any further meetings hereinbefore assigned.

The Mayor, or the Vice-Chairman of the City Council, or any four members thereof, may at any time call a special meeting by causing written notices, stating the time of holding such meeting and signed by the person calling the same, to be delivered in hand to each member of the City Council, or left at his usual dwelling place, at least twelve hours before the time of such meeting. Meeting of the city council may also be held at any time when all the members of the City Council are present and consent thereto.
