All Ordinances
Establishing the salaries of certain officers, and for other purposes

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

Section 1 The annual salaries of the several officers named in this section shall be as follows: The Board of Assessors, thirty six hundred dollars. The Treasurer of the City and Collector of Taxes, which both offices are held by the same person, twenty five hundred dollars. The Chief of Police, fifteen hundred dollars. The Superintendent of Streets and Drains, fifteen hundred dollars, and the City Messenger ~~seven~~ ^{seven} hundred dollars - which sums shall be paid in equal quarterly payments and shall be in full for all services rendered in an official capacity.

Section 2 The foregoing section shall take effect as of the first secondary of January last.

Section 3 There shall be paid the Assistant Assessors four dollars a day each, for every day's service rendered to the City in their official capacity.

Section 4 All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this one hereby repealed.
