I regret to inform you that in the opinion of the City Solicitor you are not entitled to an annuity under Section 95A of Chapter 32, as your husband did not take the option to receive a lesser annual amount which would have reserved for you the right to receive two-thirds of his pension. Your only recourse, if any, would be to seek special legislation from the General Court.
