COUNCILLOR WALSH

- ORDERED: That the City Manager request all vendors who do business with the City of Cambridge on a daily or weekly basis without benefit of a bidding process to confirm by signed affidavit that they, the vendors, are bona fide equal opportunity employers. Further, that the City Manager ascertain how many of the vendors themselves are minorities as well as the percentage of minorities employed as staff persons by each and every such vendor; and be it further
- ORDERED: That effective immediately, every new vendor who applies to carry out such non-bid business with the City of Cambridge must provide the referenced signed affidavit to the City Manager prior to the City's engaging the services of said vendor; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to this Council with the requested data by May 21, 1990 and, at the same time, confirm that henceforth this policy is operative and will be implemented throughout every City Department.
