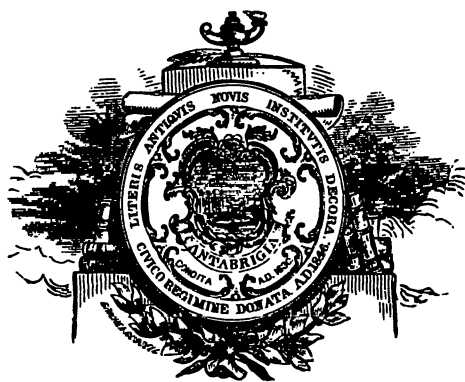




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Hastings Square - so-called,
between Chestnut and Henry streets, and northwest
of the enclosed square of the same name,

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land

_____ in width between *Forty feet*
Chestnut and Henry streets,

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *the City Engineer*
and dated *July 20. 1882*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid,
