- WHEREAS: A near fatality recently occurred involving a Parking Control Officer, who, while in the performance of his duty, was shot and severely injured; and
- WHEREAS: The possibility exists that this employee was mistaken to be a police officer by his assailant, who may have been in the process of committing a crime; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Director of Traffic and Parking, in order to consider the feasibility of changing the color of the uniforms worn by Parking Control Officers, as well as to consider the issuance of walkietalkies to the officers so that they will have the ability to communicate with the Department in the event of an emergency.


