It has come to my attention that on September 30, 1974, there will be a Public Hearing on the proposed acceptance of Lot-6 as a Public Way off of Aberdeen Avenue.

Presently, this piece of land is used as a short-cut by motorists to avoid the intersection of Aberdeen Avenue and Mt. Auburn Street. This should be stopped by the owner of the existing parking lot. This could be done by chaining off or close in some way the entrances after hours.

Another problem is the parking on Mt. Auburn Street in front of the Social Security Building. In order to maintain a smooth flow of traffic and avoid large tie-ups, that section of Mt. Auburn Street must be kept clear. The vehicles that park their cars there are continually being towed by the Police Department. This problem could be reduced, if visitors' parking was made available, off-street, and if it were adequately signed.
