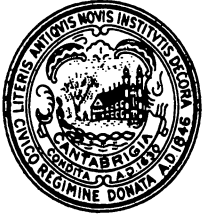
It will be appreciated if you will consider the following transfer


