Petition of The Western Union Telegraph Company for authority to increase rates and charges in the basic message telegraph zoned rates, upward revision in the minimum telegraphic money order charge from 15¢ to 25¢, upward adjustment in rental and installation charges for certain items of equipment furnished in connection with leased facility service, together with other changes as shown in rate schedules and tariffs on file with the Department.
