To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 18, regarding a report on the operational status of the traffic lights on Monsignor O'Brien Highway and Museum Way, Traffic, Parking & Transportation Director Susan Clippinger reports the following:

The signal at Monsignor O'Brien Highway and Industrial Park Drive is currently still owned by the developer Congress Group Ventures who has purchased and installed the hardware necessary to take this signal off flash and make it operational. They are working with the MDC to put this signal in operation, have it fully functional for thirty days, and then turn it over to the MDC who will own and operate the signal. The State Police had a problem with the queue extending back into Leverett Circle and have requested adjustments to the signal timing to resolve this issue. Congress Group is responsible for resolving the problems to put this signal into operation.
