- WHEREAS: In 1937, Mary G. Murphy was promoted as a permanent employee to Junior Clerk/Typist, and
- WHEREAS: On April 1, 1943 Mary G. Murphy was promoted as Senior Clerk/Typist, and
- WHEREAS: On August 19, 1958 Mary G. Murphy was promoted as Principal Clerk of the Board of Assessors to oversee all administrative functions of the Board of Assessors, and
- WHEREAS: On August 12, 1970 Mary G. Murphy was promoted to the position of Head Clerk, as general supervisor of the administrative and clerical functions of the office, and
- WHEREAS: In May of 1975, the Middlesex Assessors Association honored Mary Murphy for her long years of exemplary assessing administrative duties, and
- WHEREAS: Mary G. Murphy has exemplified the word "public servant" and has devoted over 49 years of her life on behalf of this City, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Mary G. Murphy for her outstanding dedication to this City, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mary G. Murphy in behalf of this entire City Council.
