Petition of Boston Edison Company for approval and authorization by the Department of Public Utilities of an increase in its authorized capital stock by the issuance and sale of not exceeding 1,000,000 shares of new common stock of the par value of ten dollars (\$10) per share and by the issuance and sale of not exceeding 400,000 shares of a fourth series of its Cumulative Preferred Stock of the par value of one hundred dollars (\$100) per share. Both issues to be sold at a price to be approved by the Department, the proceeds from such issues and sales to be used for the financing and funding of expenditures for extensions, additions and improvements to the Company's plant and properties and to the payment of obligations of the Company representing such expenditures.
