WHEREAS: This City Council desires more detailed information about the proposal embodied in the OCS grant, relative to the private financing aspects and the use of public resources proposed to finance this operation, and requires more detailed information regarding neighborhood involvement in the proposed development, together with the location of the proposed facility, prior to taking any action on the proposal as offered; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is directed to establish an "un-expendable allotment account" of \$1,000,000. for this grant until such time as the above referenced information and action is completed, at which time the City Manager would submit same to this Council for its approval by majority vote for any request to expend this allotment.
