- WHEREAS: These products can seep into the ground, contaminate water supplies and end up in Boston Harbor further polluting the environment; and
- WHEREAS: People are generally unaware of the potential dangers of carelessly storing and disposing of common household substances; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That I, Alfred E. Vellucci, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, do establish April 29, 1989, as **HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL DAY**; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That all citizens of Cambridge are invited and urged to bring their hazardous waste materials to the Municipal Parking Lot, #9, behind the Central Square Post Office on Saturday, April 29, 1989, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
