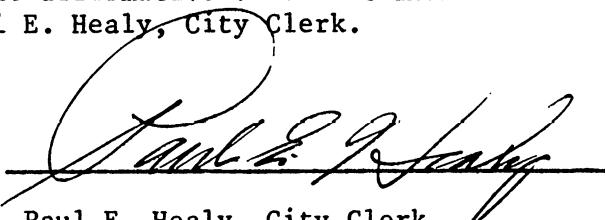

- WHEREAS: Ibis found himself given sanctuary in the home of Al Vellucci for one month in 1971 and was finally returned to its perch atop the buffoonery castle on Bow and Arrow Street; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record commending the Crimson for giving Ibis two days of freedom and liberty and sanctuary "free from Lampoon lampoonery"; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Ibis be declared as the official bird for Cambridge and that all diplomatic courtesies be extended to all Ibis bird lovers at the Harvard Crimson.
