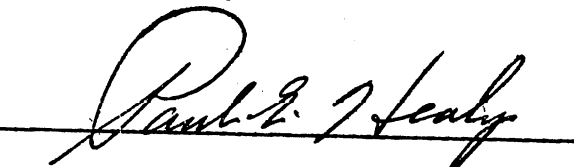

- WHEREAS: Gerald continued his education, receiving a Master's Degree in Physical Education in 1965 from Boston University and upon completion of his graduate education, he continued to pursue his love for sports, teaching and coaching both soccer and lacrosse at Dean Junior College, Lafayette College, Fairleigh Dickinson University and Tufts University; and
- WHEREAS: Gerald not only was an outstanding athlete, but a devoted husband, father and family man who always put family before anything else in life; now therefore be it
