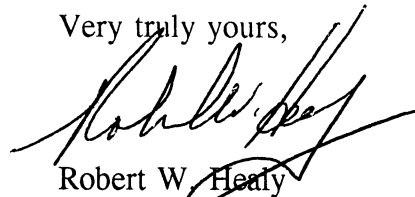

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$23,702.00 in property taxes to the Election Commission Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to provide funds for various costs related to the 1997 municipal election. At the time the FY98 budget was adopted, approval to use the new computerized Proportional Representation voting and tabulation system had not been received. Since then, the Secretary of the Commonwealth has approved the system with certain requirements to ensure that voters receive proper instruction in the use of the system. This request incorporates those requirements as well as recommendations of the City Council and Election Commission.

The request comprises a sample ballot mailing to voters; large print ballots for polling locations; demonstrators at polling locations during the week of October 13, 1997; demonstrators at polling locations on Election Day; a complete test of the system on September 13, 1997; minimal software adaptation; and the training of inspectors for Election Day.
