- WHEREAS: Recently the Community Development Department prepared a comprehensive ordinance relative to the regulation of signs throughout this city, and
- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of some members of this Council that major business within our city have not been contacted by anyone from the Community Development Department to seek the input and advise of these businessmen, and
- WHEREAS: At some future date, the Ordinance Committee of this City Council will conduct a public hearing on this issue, prior to any formal action by the Council, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record requesting the City Manager to appoint an advisory committee comprised of the Acting Administrator of the Community Development Department, a representative from the Chamber of Commerce and other businessmen who will be effected by such a sign ordinance, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this Committee meet and review the proposed ordinance prior to a public hearing before the Ordinance Committee, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this Committee prepare recommendations for review by this Council in order to ensure that any action taken by this body is in full accord with state law, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That no action be taken by the Ordinance Committee on the proposed sign ordinance until the aforementioned request have been met.
