I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$54,820.00 in the Grant Fund of the Public Celebration Salary and Wages Account (\$2,741.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$52,079.00). The Massachusetts Cultural Council has awarded funds to the Cambridge Arts Council's Grant Program, to be distributed to Cambridge artists and arts organizations to benefit the citizens of Cambridge through the arts. This grant is supplemented by a \$15,000 match, which was approved in the FY00 budget. Approximately 26 artists and/or organizations will receive small grants to present their art and/or programming in the city.
