In Board of Aldermen, *July 7. 1888.*

Ordered,

That James M. Hilton be authorized to lay and maintain a steam-pipe under the sidewalk on the south-west side of Harvard Street, from no. 440 to no. 448. The right to lay and maintain such steam-pipe as aforesaid, is given under the following conditions, viz: Said Hilton shall file a plan of said pipe in the office of the City Engineer before commencing to lay the same, and the entire matter shall be under the direction of the City Engineer and Superintendent of Streets and subject to their approval. Said pipe shall be removed whenever the Board of Aldermen shall so require. Said Hilton shall also file with the City Clerk, a satisfactory bond in the sum of Three Thousand Dollars, to hold the city harmless from all claims for damages, arising on account of the laying and maintenance of said pipe.
