- WHEREAS: Child care is a major need in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: The House of Representatives is currently considering The Early Childhood Education and Development Act of 1989 (H.R. 3), an act comparable to the ACT for Better Child Care passed by the Senate in June that will help to fund child care, to improve quality, and to develop additional child care options, including after-school progress; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council go on record as urging Representative Kennedy, who is a co-sponsor of the bill, to provide strong leadership and support for this legislation and; be it further
- RESOLVED: That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Representative and to other members of the Massachusetts delegation in Congress.
