The Cambridge City Council, to which was referred the re-zoning petition of Clifford Truesdell et al, conducted a public hearing on Wednesday, February 15, 1978 beginning at 5 P. M. in the City Council Chamber. The City Council wishes to submit the following report:

David Vickery, Assistant City Manager for Community Development, presented the Planning Board's favorable recommendation including two amendments.

Speaking in favor of this petition were - Mr. Clifford Truesdell, IV, 29 Essex Street; Mr. Gerald Bergman, 27A Essex Street; Ms. Germaine M. Green, 35½ Essex Street; Mr. James Peters (Representing Cambridge Civic Association), Pearl Street.

At the request of Vice-Mayor Frisoli, a show of hands were made of those in favor and 18 hands were erected. No one appeared before this hearing in opposition to this petition.

The Planning Board has recommended that this petition be approved subject to the following amendments:

That the Essex/Norfolk Street area of the petition, proposed to be rezoned to Residence B, remain in its existing Residence C-1 designation; and

That the Prospect Street area of the petition proposed to be rezoned to Residence C-1, be rezoned to Business A-1.
