That the City Manager be requested to instruct the Chief of Police to meet with planning representatives of the Community Development Department in order to do a neighborhood by neighborhood survey of all thirteen City neighborhoods which will indicate whether or not the residents, the business sectors, the cultural institutions and all other groups are receiving adequate police protection; and be it further

ORDERED:

That a comprehensive neighborhood analysis be returned to the City Council at the earliest possible date.
