- WHEREAS: The development of this surplus is a result of a combination of factors, including good city-management, fiscal constraint and economic sacrifice by our municipal employees; and
- WHEREAS: The municipal department heads, under the direction of the City Manager have and continue to be industrious, hardworking and sincere management personnel who are now deserving of monetary recognition; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested prior to the adoption by the City Council of the municipal budget for FY86-87, to provide a sum sufficient for the granting of substantial salary adjustments for these department heads and to submit said recommendation to the Council within three weeks.
