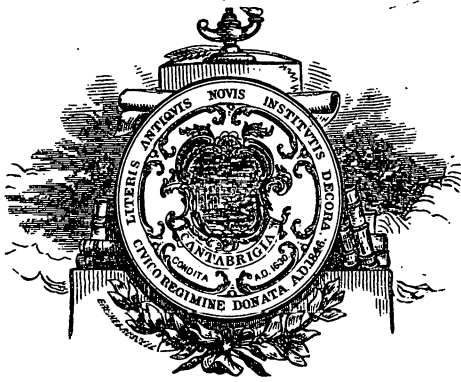

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Aug. 13. 1885.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that Winslow Street so-called, extending from Garden Street, southwesterly about One hundred and ninety feet, and thence at a right angle northwesterly about One hundred and ninety feet to Orrin Street, so-called,

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land ^{thirty feet} in width between Garden Street, and a point about one hundred and ninety feet southwesterly, and thence extending from said point, at a right angle, about one hundred and ninety feet to Orrin Street, ^{so-called,} included between the ^{red} lines as shown on a plan drawn by W. A. Mason and Sen. Surveyor, dated Nov. 25. 1885,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that ^{no} damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, the owners and abutters having waived the usual notice, and agreed to make no claim for such damages.

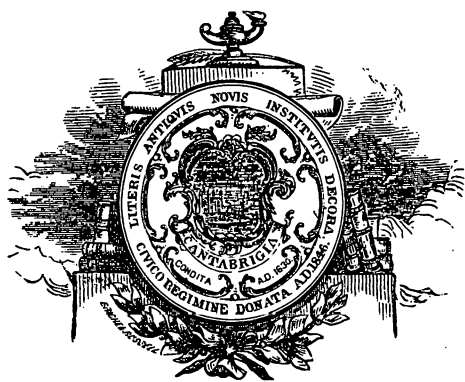

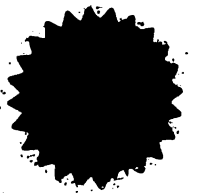
