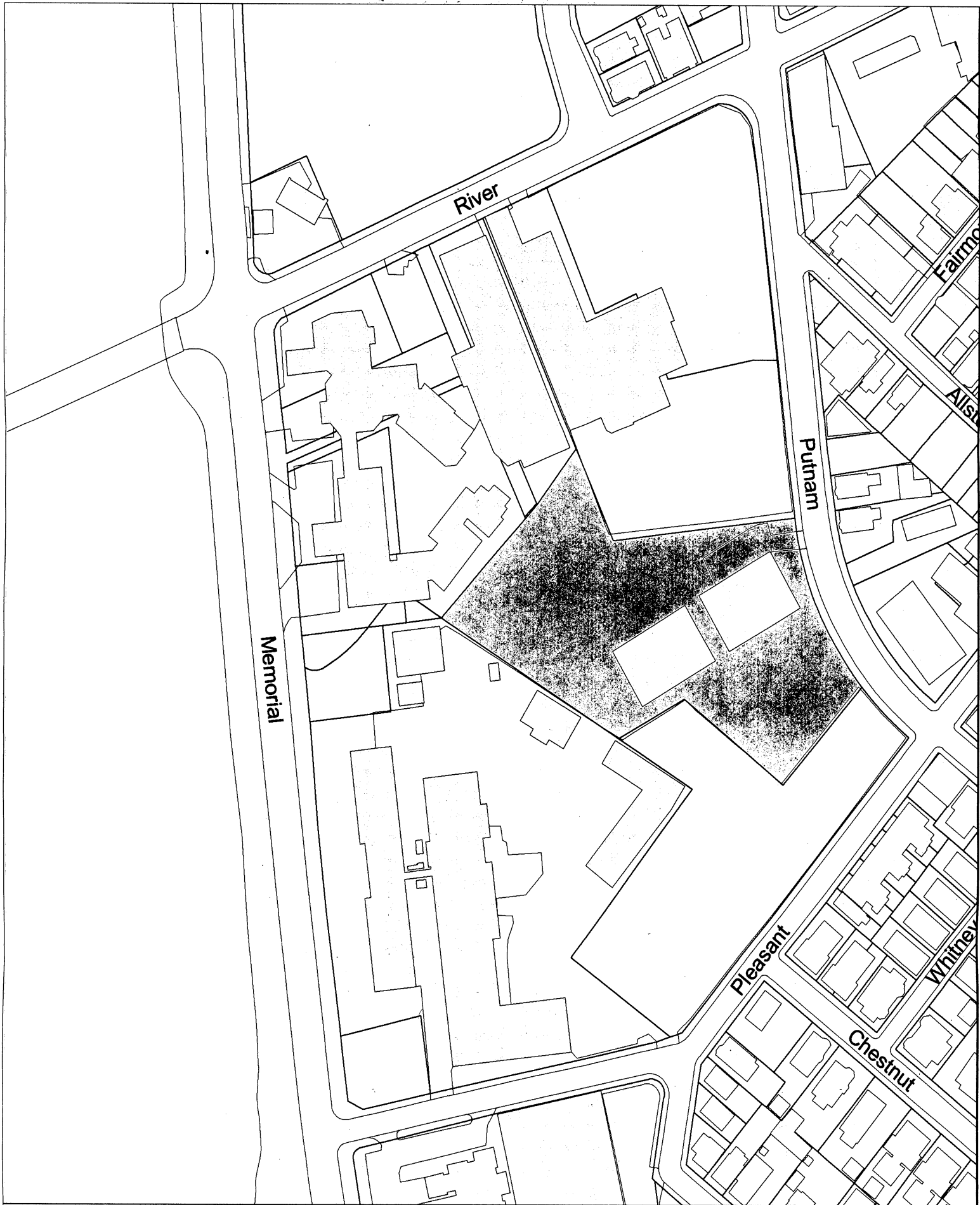

My staff contacted Paul Casey, Director of Real Estate and Government Affairs for ComElectric, regarding the availability of the above referenced property. Mr. Casey stated that the subject property is not available for sale. According to Mr. Casey, this property is an existing substation and is necessary to the operation of Cambridge Electric's distribution system throughout Cambridge. Power is received from Boston at the substation and is then distributed to Cambridge customers.

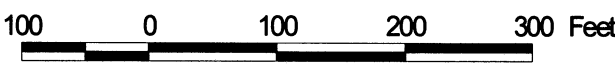
A plan outlining the boundaries of the site is attached.

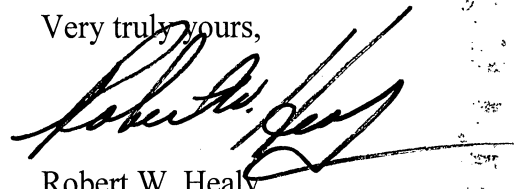
