TAGE LARSEN

Horns blow for Larsen

Tage Larsen, of Garden Street, 1992 graduate of Michigan State University, won the Louis Sudler Prize, the highest student honor awarded by the College of Arts and Letters. The \$1,000 prize, awarded at 14 universities, is given to a graduate for outstanding achievement in the creative or performing arts.

Tage received a bachelor of music degree in trumpet performance. While at MSU he was principal trumpet for four years in the MSU Symphony Orchestra, section leader in the MSU Wind Symphony, lead solo in the MSU Jazz Ensemble, and a member of the Faculty Brass Quintet.

He was also a member of the Lansing Symphony Orchestra and the Battle Creek Symphony Orchestra. Tage has performed with Jon Wynton Marsalis and Bob Hope. He was Outstanding Soloist at the Notre Dame Jazz Festival, Outstanding Performer at the Montreux Jazz Festival, and recently was offered the position of principal trumpet with the Jerusalem Symphony Orchestra in Israel.

Tage graduated in 1984 from the Peabody School and 1988 from the Pilot School of Cambridge Rindge and Latin, where he was a member of the orchestra and Bob Ponte's Jazz Ensemble. He played with Ponte in Cambridge's sister city of Yerevan, Armenia. He was also a member of the Greater Boston Youth Symphony Orchestra.

Tage will go to graduate school at Eastman School of Music at the University of Rochester in the fall. He is the oldest of 10 kids of Rikk and Pam Larsen of Cambridge.
