COUNCILLOR SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that John G. Caulfield, Master of the Martin Luther King School, will be inducted into the Hall of Fame of Harvard University on Friday, October 20, 1978; and
- WHEREAS: John G. Caulfield has been a life long resident of Cambridge where he attended local schools and acquired his interest in baseball while playing at the grammar school level and on the playgrounds of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: John G. Caulfield's outstanding athletic ability was obvious to anyone who watched him play as evidenced by the fact that John was offered a professional contract with the Boston Braves when he was a junior in high school, however John declined in order to finish his high school education; and
- WHEREAS: John G. Caulfield received an academic scholarship to Harvard University in 1944 but interrupted his academic career and served our country in the United States Navy during World War II; and
- WHEREAS: At the completion of the war, John returned to Harvard where he played four years of varsity baseball, leading the team in hitting during his sophomore year, was Captain of the team as a senior and led the Eastern Intercollegiate Baseball League; and
- WHEREAS: John had coached baseball for seventeen years at both Rindge Tech and Cambridge High and Latin prior to assuming his duties in 1968 as Master of the King Elementary School; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere congratulations to John G. Caulfield on this momentous occasion; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to John and Barbara Caulfield as a permanent remembrance to this joyous occasion.
