Gentlemen:

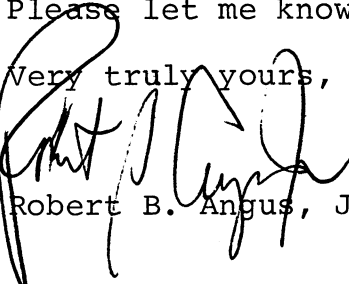
Upon returning from a holiday, I discovered that daytime off-street parking, specifically between Brattle and Mount Auburn Streets near Brattle Square, is now barred to all but residents of the area. I work for a business that requires me to use my car, often daily, in order to meet clients in the metropolitan Boston area.

The loss of the parking lot near the planned Kennedy library complex, coupled with "renovation" of old buildings in the area without the construction of additional parking facilities, has severely handicapped those of us who wish to obey the law and also earn a living in Cambridge.

If you do not wish to grant concessions to those of us whose business cannot be performed without primary access to private transportation, then I shall recommend to my company that further expansion should not be considered within the city limits of Cambridge. Are you trying to drive the few revenue-producing business people from your tax roles?

Please let me know how to apply for a parking permit.
