ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Commissioner of Public Works, and the Director of the Cambridge Historical Commission, and the City Engineer to undertake an in-depth examination at the snow that accumulates on the roof of this historic building that makes it hazardous to the persons entering and leaving the building, as the snow melts and slides off the slate roof and crashes to the ground or on the cars surrounding the area; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager and the above mentioned staff explore ways of averting a serious accident, by putting up a catch-all (ie. steel rods) to collect the snow and ice and let it melt naturally before an accident happens.
