This is to advise you that the License Commission police officer, Michael McMahon has investigated the complaint with regard to the above order. I enclose his report for your information.

At present, he has not observed any noise violations in that area. He did speak with Iveco Trucks and Donahue Plumbing on the issues of noise and traffic congestion. They have agreed to monitor the situation to maintain good neighborhood relations.

The landlord of the building at 33 Richdale Ave., Joan Wilson, has also assured Officer McMahon that she will monitor the situation.

Officer McMahon will continue to monitor the situation periodically to assure compliance. It would be helpful in the future to know who are the exact complainants so that we may question them for specifics.

In regards to Council Order #34, directing intensified surveillance of Richdale Av. area on complaints of parking, noise, pollution, etc. the result of trucks associated with Iveco Trucks, 47-51 Richdale Av.,

I have observed this area several times in the past week, in the morning, afternoon, and evening hours, and observed no traffic or parking violations. Also heard no unnecessary noise, or observed any pollution from truck engines running.

I spoke with Mr. Calvin H. Brandford the owner of Iveco Trucks 47-51 Richdale Av., he denied any violations from his business practices. But he assured me he will monitor any activity of his business, with regards to the above mentioned violations, and wants to maintain good relations with the neighbors.

Also spoke with Edward T. Donahue of Donahue Plumbing located in the same building, 33 Richdale Av., he also assured me he will monitor his business practices with regards to neighborhood relations.

I also received a telephone call from Ms. Joan Wilson the owner of the building, she was very concerned about any neighborhood complaints regarding her tenants, and she will also monitor any violations.

I will continue to conduct periodical surveillance of this area to assure compliance.

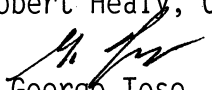
