In Board of Aldermen, May 5, 1885

Ordered,

Resolved,

That upon payment to the city Treasurer of the sum of Five Hundred dollars to John E. Cassidy, the said Cassidy be released from his contracts with the city in the matter of a Gravel Bank at Woburn, purchased of him in Dec. 1879, - One contract being for the sale of the gravel, and the other for the delivery of the same in this city, Also that he be released from the bond given by him to the city, dated Dec. 29. 1879.

The amount so paid to be credited to the Revenue account of the Appropriation for Street Department, (Repairs,)

Provided, That the Superintendent of Streets shall have the right to take away all the gravel upon the place that is screened, and also the Field Stone now on the land, at any time during the present season.
