

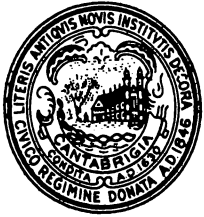

To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached appropriation transfer of \$40,000 from Library Salaries and Wages to Other Ordinary Maintenance is requested to cover computer costs. The Library plans to upgrade the data storage system of the current Model 12 to a Model 20; to expand the capacity for storing data at the Main Library and the Central Square Library; to upgrade the local Digilog keyboard station to a remote composite station for Central Square; and to make the final payment on the LIBS 100 Equipment Lease/Purchase Agreement.
