- WHEREAS:** It has come to the attention of this City Council that a severe rodent problem exists in and around the Saint Peter's Field and Bellis Circle area, and
- WHEREAS:** This problem has caused great concern throughout the neighborhood, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works and the Commissioner of Health and Hospitals to immediately develop a program for the extermination of these rodents, and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the Commissioner of Public Works and Commissioner of Health and Hospitals consult with the City Solicitor prior to the implementation of said program in order to determine the most effective way of using poisonous chemicals without endangering neighborhood dogs and cats who may be within the area.
