Sept. 7, 1874,

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

First Street
between Otis and Thorndike Streets
should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *fifty* feet
in width between

Otis and Thorndike Streets

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

C. H. Fowler

dated June 15, 1874,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *and*
that thirty days be allowed for the
removal of all fences or other obstructions
standing thereon.
