
To the Honorable, the City Council:

The License Commission has requested a transfer of \$605.00 in their budget for 1975-76 in order to maintain one temporary clerical position through the license renewal period, April 1st to May 15th. During this period, 5500 walk-in and/or mail-in renewals will be processed. In order to keep waiting time for people requesting renewals to a minimum, this temporary help has been requested.

The surplus funds for this transfer are available as a result of License's participation in our Records Management program. The "ordinary maintenance" portion of the License budget contains money for extra office equipment, filing cabinets, etc., that will no longer be needed, as we will be microfilming most of their files in the near future.
