Belmont Street between Mount Auburn Street and the Cambridge-Belmont line;

IN BELMONT: Belmont Street between the Cambridge-Belmont line and Trapelo Road;

Trapelo Road between Belmont Street and Benton Square;

Benton Square between Trapelo Road and Belmont Street;

Belmont Street between Benton Square and Trapelo Road.
