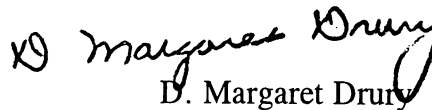

"My 8 Rules for Safety"

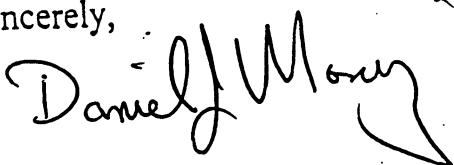

I am a Repair Technician for Bell Atlantic. I have spoken with police chiefs in my work area including Rockport, Gloucester, Essex, Hamilton, Wenham, Beverly, Danvers and Salem. Some have heard about this, some have not. I gave them each one and they are looking into it along with their safety officers. I live in a community in Hamilton called Asbury Grove. I'm involved with safety and security. I've passed these out to the families. I continue to pass them out to families and friends.

After this recent tragedy in Cambridge, I felt I could do a great service in providing these rules of safety to the public. I have contacted John Walsh from America's Most Wanted to see if there is some way to have these safety rules reach out to all elementary school age children and their families throughout the country. I carry a supply in my work truck and pass them out to customers with children after repairing their telephones.

We have two daughters, Kellyann age 8, and Sherilyn age 7. Our hearts and prayers are with the Curley Family.
